

Academic Misconduct



1 Definition

Academic Misconduct involves

- providing aid or assistance in relation to,
- creating or making,
- obtaining or acquiring, or
- using

information, services or equipment that may unfairly give a Student an unauthorised advantage relative to other Students with regard to a Formal Examination or other Assessment Item.

'Unauthorised advantage' includes any advantage not identified for the Formal Examination or Assessment work.

Academic Misconduct includes but is not limited to Collusion, Plagiarism, contract cheating, impersonation of a Student or University Employee, and Failure to Comply with Formal Examination or Assessment Instructions.
